



## COVID Update May 25th 2021

**We have reviewed the latest COVID-19 directions advice and have provided a summary of what this means for men's sheds.**

**These changes apply from 6pm Tuesday 25 May until at least 4 June.**

### **Key points for men's sheds**

#### **In Greater Melbourne:**

- Indoor public gatherings are restricted to 30 people.
- Masks are mandatory indoors in all settings for all people 12 and over unless an exemption applies.
- Masks can be removed for eating and drinking and other purposes where is it necessary, such as getting a hair cut.

#### **Outside Greater Melbourne**

- Masks are not mandatory indoors UNLESS one or more visitors is attending from Greater Melbourne.

- If a person from Greater Melbourne is attending a shed for a gathering the maximum number of attendees is 30.

#### **All of Victoria**

- From the 28<sup>th</sup> of May **all** sheds must have the Victorian Government QR code system set up and in use.
- Where it's not feasible for visitors to use the QR code, or for the shed to check them in on a device, a paper back-up system is acceptable.
- The density limit changes planned for 28 May are on hold.
- Visitors to hospitals and aged care facilities must wear masks.
